

Guide to Commenting on EPA's New Carbon Emissions Standards

Here's how you comment:

- ✓ **Address your email to a-and-r-docket@epa.gov with the subject line “Docket ID No. EPA-HQ-OAR-2023-0072.”**

- ✓ **Tell EPA who you are and where you live.**

- ✓ **Tell them you support the “New Source Performance Standards for Greenhouse Gas Emissions from Existing Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units.”**

- ✓ **Tell them why. For instance, you understand the connection between GHGs and the climate damage we're witnessing in Montana. These proposals contain reasonably priced available technologies for reducing these emissions.**

- ✓ **Finally, you might mention changes in the regulations. For instance, the EPA should speed up enforcement. If coal-burning generators like Colstrip choose not to adopt emissions controls, they close by 2025 rather than continue until 2032.**
